This printable creates two complete Scripture Jar sets, one for you and one to gift.

Each jar holds color-coded verses to meet you right where you are, whether joyful, anxious, thankful, lonely, angry, or sad.

Printing Guide

Print this instruction page (Page 1) on white paper.

Then print the remaining pages single-sided on the colored paper listed below.

Tip: Load your printer tray in this order: one white sheet for this page, one more for the label, then two sheets of each color in sequence. This produces two identical sets (two jars total if you’re gifting).

Cut & Assemble

- Cut out each individual Scripture strip.
- Fold the verses and place them in a jar together — all six colors in one jar.
- Use the white label (Page 2) to decorate your jar.

Enjoy & Share

Keep one jar close — on your kitchen counter, nightstand, or homeschool table — and gift the second set to a friend or fellow mom.
